Miscellanies

Dear colleagues, please be welcome to the 2010 SSAC Basketball Tournament in Buenos Aires.

Important information to share with coaches and players.

1. All the game will be rule by the FIBA Rules
 - Local team will start on the left side (view from the table) and visiting teams will start on right side.
 - 90 minutes per game. Warm-up begins immediately upon competition after previous game. Games will start at schedule time.
2. Off-Limit Areas -
 - Field areas.
 - High School Building – Except student Center (third Floor)
 - Coach must accompany players when using the Computer lab/HS Library.
 - Elementary and Middle School Classrooms Areas.

-Players are expected to stay in the gyms area so that Elem, MS and HS classes are not disturbed. Each team will have a room to store equipment and relax between games.

 - FDR, Ambassador will be Hugo Otero. Room assigned Pool Boys Lookers room.
 - ASQ, Ambassador will be Daniel Reyes Room assigned Pool Girls Lookers room.
 - UAS, Ambassador will be Alejandra G. Room assigned Fitness Center.
 - Nido, Ambassador will be Mariana G...Room assigned Gym Storage Room.

Please keep own place neat and tidy. Throw all garbage in trash bin.

3. ID Badges -

Each player, coach and AD will be issued a Lincoln ID badge. ID Badges must be shown before entering campus. They must be with players, coaches and AD when on Campus, must be shown in the cafeteria in order to receive lunch. If lost please report to AD or coach. ID Badges will be collected at the end of the tournament.

4. Computers (Players Use) -

The computers will be available only during the school day, please follow the schedule assigned to your school. See last page of this document. Inappropriate behavior or use of computer will result in loss of computer privileges and AD informed. Coaches will use Lap-tops in the coaches' room.

5- Locker rooms in the new gym -

Player can use the lockers in the new gym. Please tell your athletes to bring a towel. Players should lock up equipment in the lockers. Players are responsible for their own equipment. Player should bring their own lock if they wish to use the lockers.

- The locker room area and hallways outside the gym floor is an area just for coaches and players. Parents and visitors must access the bleachers via the lobby.

5. Kiosko -

The School Kiosko will be open during all three days of the tournament. Drinks, snacks, sandwiches and other food items will be for sale in the kiosko. The kiosko will only accept Argentine Pesos.

6. Weather/Clothing -

We are currently experiencing sunny warm weather. Weather: During SAAC expecting temperatures in the 70s (degrees Fahrenheit) / low 20s (degrees Celsius). At night, the temperature may drop to 60s (degrees Fahrenheit) / 15-16 (degrees Celsius). Bring warm clothing for the evenings, as it can get cool, and the Gym has no heat.

Jacket or sweater should also be packed. Encourage your athletes to bring a towel.

7. Changing Money

It would be best to change money at the airport. <http://www.dolarsi.com/>

It would be best to bring US Dollars. Dollars can also be changed at a local bank 2 blocks from the school from 10:00 – 3:00. Other currencies can only be changed at the airport or in the city center.

8. Trips – (**Wednesday** Shopping Dot, **Friday** Recoleta and **Saturday** Parque de la Costa.

Players cannot leave the mall or Plaza Francia Area. Outside these areas will be considered Off-Limits. SAAC By-Laws V-B “Off-Limit Area and V-C “Exploration of the local environment” will be applied. By-laws V-B and V-C listed below.

Teams should stay together. Keep camera, cell phones, and handbags secure. The shopping could be an area where pickpockets frequently visit.

Friday and Saturday night trips for SAAC players and Lincoln host students.

All players must ride the bus to Recoleta on Friday and to Parque de la Costa on Saturday and return with the group by the buses arranged by Lincoln. Lincoln players must attend this trip and must ride on the bus. They may not travel by their own cars. The entrance fee to the park will be covered but any extra food or drinks will be the responsibility of the individual players and coaches.

10. Open Ceremony –

On Thursday, all the players should arrive to Lincoln dressed in uniforms for the Open Ceremony and the General picture. Details about the O.C. will be given to coaches/ADs in the meeting on Wednesday at 6:00 PM.

11- Food –

Cereal bars, bananas, apples and drinks will be distribute to all players.
During games we will provide bottle water.

12- Laundry. –

Uniforms will be sent to be washed on Thursday and Friday. Make sure to collect them and bring them to the office in the bag we will provide to each school. Let your students know they need to bring two extra towels each.

13- Our PE stuff will make sure to keep the girls and boys games on time during the Tournament, so warm-up balls, water, ice and other needs please see assigned PE teachers. The warm-up begins immediately upon competition after previous game. Games will start at schedule time.

14. Documents and Airplane tickets –

AD's will collect all school delegation tickets and traveling documents for safe keeping.

15. Rules –

On Wednesday at 6:00 all coaches and referees will meet to go through all the rules.
On Friday at 6:30, all BB coaches will meet to discuss possible changes or recommendations for the BB rules for the futures SAAC's It will be important to have any suggestions in write. These suggestions will have to be approved for all AD's.

16. Coaches dinners and curfew calls–

- After the Wednesday meeting we will walk to Chivito Jose (2 blocks away) to have dinner. Each coach / school will be responsible for their food and drinks at Chivito Jose
- Thursday 7:30 Dinner for all coaches will be served in school. Gym Foyer.
- Friday night dinner – Coaches Responsible.
- Saturday BBQ awards ceremony at Lincoln.
- Each school coach will call athletes every day at curfew time. Problems will be reported to own AD. AD will call the host AD immediately.

17. Training sessions –

Training sessions on Wednesday will be scheduled if requested.

18. Half times. Each team will decide if they will go to the teams room or stay in the gym during half time. When playing in the old gym Local team will go to balcony, visiting teams can use the multipurpose room in the basement of mansion.

19. Visitor parents. Let us know in advance if any visitor from your school will come to watch the games so we can inform the guards.
